DO YOU REMEMBER FEELING BLESSED BY A HANDWRITTEN NOTE OR CARD FROM A CHRISTIAN BROTHER OR SISTER YOU'D NEVER MET? PLEASE CONSIDER PASSING IT ON BY WRITING GENERAL AGAPE FOR THE PILGRIMS ON THE UPCOMING WALKS.

As a reminder, **General Agape** is given to the pilgrims in the first and second drops on Saturday at 3:21 PM and 9:25 PM. **Personal Agape** from family and friends is delivered in the third drop on Sunday at 11:32 AM. All agape must fit into a paper "lunch size" bag. Please save any gifts or large items for the journey home.

Both General and Personal Agape can be dropped off at the Agape Room in Moody Retreat Center. Place your agape in the appropriate boxes no later than one hour before each drop to allow the team members ample time to sort and deliver. The Agape Room will close at 9 PM each evening so the team can rest and prepare to serve the pilgrims the following day. Please respect the teams' privacy during the weekends, and keep visits to the Agape Room short and for the purpose of delivering agape only.

For your convenience, an Agape Box will be placed in the back of the barn on Saturday night during the Candlelight Service. You can place your Personal Agape (to be delivered in the third drop on Sunday) in this box rather than taking it to Moody Retreat Center.

Thanking you in advance for supporting the men and women walks. As Christ taught us, "**Be devoted to one another in love.**" *Romans 12:10*. What better way to show devotion and love to one another than through written words of love and encouragement!

Open EOOE Board Positions

Secretary - the person fulfilling this role would be responsible for attending all board meetings and recording the minutes. Minutes would then be sent out to all board members before the next meeting so that all can be reviewed. This person works directly with the Community Lay director and may be asked to perform other administrative duties.

Pre-Walk - this is a rotating position with two other members of the pre-walk team. They are responsible for collecting and processing applications and financial commitments for the weekends. They are in direct communication with the sponsors and make sure that all sponsor duties are understood.

At Large - this member of the board write this article! They are responsible for recruiting board members, helping new members understand their role and being a general member representing the community. A clear understanding of by-laws and regulations is important in advising the board overall.

These are the positions available at this time. As new information is received, this list may be updated. All above positions are to be fulfilled for three years. Board members are expected to attend all regular meetings that occur on the third Monday evening of each month. Other meetings may be called As needed. Board members may be asked to serve as Board Rep for walk weekends.

From the Community Lay Director

"To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:
