## Message from the Board

Dear Emmaus Brothers and Sisters,

Every year, the Board discusses raising our fees charged for team members and Pilgrims. We usually trail the growth in expenses, waiting until we see a loss in order to keep the fees as low as possible for the Pilgrims. We currently lose about \$10 per person on the Walk, meaning it is time to increase our fees. Since we changed to two Walks a year, our fixed costs have grown on a per-Pilgrim basis due to the lower number of total Pilgrims.

In the year, we have seen a few things that have made our finances get tighter than normal. A big one was the canceled Chrysalis flight last summer that cost our community \$1000. Another expense has been in updating our materials for Lay Leaders for the first time in a decade and the song book update.

We are coming to you now asking for donations to help bring us out of the red for 2019. We expect to raise our fees for 2020 as little as possible but even these fees lag a bit, as we often carry over Pilgrims from Walk to Walk due to cancelations or other changes.

I normally would not do this publicly, but I want to show that your Board is involved with solving this short-term situation. Lisa and I will personally pledge to give \$500 to the community to help with the need. Will you give, too? Any amount will do, no matter the amount. We are a family of over 4000, if all who are able can give a little, we can set our community up for many more years of faithful service and continue to make the weekends as affordable as possible.

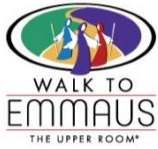
